



**Announcement of Thammasat University
on the Application and Admission
to the Master of Laws Program in Business Laws (English Program)
For the Academic Year 2017(2nd Round)**

The Faculty of Law, Thammasat University hereby announces the application and admission to Master of Laws Program in Business Laws (English Program) for the academic year 2017(2nd Round) with details as follows:

1. Program Offered

The Faculty of Law offers the Master of Laws Program in Business Laws (English Program).

2. Applicants' Qualifications

2.1 Applicants must meet the qualifications described in the regulations of Thammasat University on the Graduate Studies of B.E. 2553 (Amended Version No.9 of B.E. 2016)

2.2 Applicants must have or expect to receive the Bachelor Degree of Law from Universities accredited by Thammasat University Council.

2.3 These following documents are mandatory; Transcript of record with cumulative GPA of at least 2.75, a letter of recommendation from an academic advisor, or a lecturer who taught applicants in the Bachelor Degree, or a supervisor for supporting the application and consideration, or as approved by the Program's Executive Board.

2.4 Applicants must have achieved one of the following minimum scores on an English proficiency test listed below. You must submit an official score report that is valid for 2 years from the examination date to the Office of the LL.M. Program.

1) TU-GET : 550

2) TOEFL : 68

3) IELTS : 6.0

3. Number of Students to be Admitted

Approximately 30 applicants will be admitted to the Program

4. Application and Application Period

Applicants may apply via <http://grad.law.tu.ac.th/admission>, complete the online registration form in order to obtain the username and password, print out the statement and make a payment at KASIKORN BANK PLC, TMB BANK PLC and BANGKOK BANK PLC.

4.1 Application and Payment Period

Applicants can apply and disburse application fee from May 1, 2017 until June 20, 2017.

The applicants may submit the mandatory documents in person or via registered mail to Office of the Master of Laws Program in Business Laws (English Program) , LA 124 , 1st Floor , Faculty of Law, Thammasat University (Tha Pra Chan Campus) from May 1, 2017 to June 23, 2017

Required documents are as the following;

1. A copy of transcript of records
2. An original of TU-GET or a copy of TOEFL/IELTS result
3. A complete Recommendation Form both parts of A & B

4.2 Application Fee

The application fee is 500 Thai baht.

5. Admission Process

5.1 Qualifications

Selection criteria are conducted based on the following supporting document; Bachelor Degree Transcript, English proficient test result and a letter of recommendation from an academic advisor or a lecturer taught in a Bachelor level or a superior in support of consideration.

In case of applicants do not meet the certain requirement or has yet fulfill the conditions on academic criteria or English proficient test result. Provided that the admission committee deems appropriate, certain applicants may be invited for an additional interview in support of consideration

5.2 Interview

Shortlisted names of the qualified candidates shall be announced by the committees, to undergo the further interview examination. The assessment aims at measuring the candidates' Listening skills, English Speaking Skills, Attitude, intention and Personalities.

6. Interview Date

The eligible candidates are due for an interview on July 2, 2017 at the Faculty of Law, Thammasat University (Tha Phra Chan)

7. Registration

The Successful candidates in Master of Law Program in Business Law (English Program) are requested to register your name as students of the program via www.reg.tu.ac.th as well as to submit the registration form during July 11-14, 2017

8. The First Date of Semester

The first semester of academic year 2017 will begin on August 21, 2017.
